


Your gift will grow your parish and expand the reach of Christ's love to those who need it most. Your tax-deductible donation will fund important works such as:

- Youth and young adults ministry in our parishes
- The construction of new Catholic schools
- Social Justice efforts: Anti-human trafficking, refugees, migrant farm workers, homelessness ministry
- Family Life Programs: parenting and marriage enrichment
- Prison ministry: support for prisoner, former inmates, families and victims of crime

The Diocesan goal this year is \$3,100.000. Our parish portion of that goal is \$16,000. Once our parish goal is met, all additional funds raised (minus administration costs) will be directed back to our parish. Last year our parish raised \$74,172.96, from which \$57,223.91 was directed back to our parish. This years parish goal is to raise \$80,000. With the rebate, we hope to continue to build up our contingency fund for the eventual replacement of our four original furnaces and an eventual replacement of the roof. In addition to the contingency fund, the Pastoral Council has advised that we hire a part-time Youth Minister to assist families in raising their young people in the Catholic faith and in leading their teens into a deeper relationship with Jesus Christ in the greater family of the Church.
