


Pro-Life Mass and Prayer Vigil

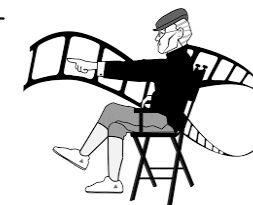
