In addition to the contingency fund, the Pastoral Council has advised that we hire a part-time Youth Minister to assist families in raising their young people in the Catholic faith and in leading their teens into a deeper relationship with Jesus Christ in the greater family of the Church.

A Great Symphony of Prayer: Mary, the Saints and Scripture


