Our Refugee couple, Amir and Fari, have arrived!

Amir and Fari are now settled into their new home in Murrayville.

Our agreement with the government is that our parish will support them financially for the first year or until they are able to support themselves. What is needed now is financial support through the parish. With a rental subsidy from the Langelyhill Housing Society, the projected monthly budget is \$2000, which includes rent, utilities, Internet and phone, food and transportation.

To donate and to receive a tax receipt, put cash or a cheque made out to Sts. Joachim & Ann Parish in an envelope marked "Refugee Support". You can also contact Madeline in the office on Tuesdays or Fridays or Sundays during office hours and she can help you make a donation electronically.

ST. CARLO ACUTIS (1991–2006) was an Italian teenager known for his profound devotion to the Eucharist and his early expertise in computer programming. He famously described the Eucharist as his "highway to heaven" and sought to share this conviction with others by using his technical skills.

EUCCHARISTIC MIRACLES EXHIBIT

To foster greater belief in the Real Presence of Jesus, Carlo designed an international digital exhibition titled *The Eucharistic Miracles of the World*. He began this ambitious project at age 11, cataloging accounts of documented miracles such as hosts transforming into human tissue or surviving fires that have occurred throughout Church history. The exhibit features panels detailing over 100 recognized Eucharistic miracles, each supported by historical accounts and research.
